

Grade 3 Learning Skills for Spring 2020

Reading/Writing

Skills to review and practice:

***Sound out words using a variety of strategies.**

** *Stretch out* words when spelling.

**Look for "chunks" in the words.

eg. *beginning, middle and end sounds*

w-ai-t f-or-k d-i-sh ea-t

***Recognize spelling patterns.**

*Complex Vowels: oi, oy, au, aw, ew, oo

*Vowels + r: ir, ur, er, ar, or

***Retell** details from stories (comprehension).

*Recognize 300-400 **Fry Sight Words**.

*Write a complete **sentence** with an **upper case letter** at the beginning and **end punctuation**.

Samples: The sun is shining. I am very excited!

**New/developing skills:

Story writing

***Plan** and **write** a simple story with a clear beginning, middle, and end.

*Parts of a story include:

setting (where the story takes place)
characters (who is in the story?) and a clear **event/situation** that the characters find themselves in.

Ask who did what, where, when, and why?

Math/Number Sense

Skills to review and practice:

***Identify and name** numbers between 0 and 1000.

*Understand that **numbers can be broken down** into 100s, 10s and 1s and each digit represents a certain quantity.
(430= 400 +30+0)

***Skip count** by 2, 5, 10 from any given number as a starting point (forward and backward).

*Solve basic **addition and subtraction** questions to 20.

***Add and subtract three digit numbers**

**without regrouping (112 + 12= 122)

***Challenge:* with regrouping: (229 + 115 = 344)

**New skills:

Measurement using centimeters, meters and kilometers

Concepts of time:

*calendar (day, week, month, year, **seasons**)

*a.m. and p.m.(second, minute, hour)

Money

*Count different combinations of coins and bills up to \$100.

*Total up a set of random coins and bills.
