
Read Aloud #1

During reading make a list of some of your favourite sensory words. Alternatively students could make a chart that includes the three senses: **See**, **Hear**, **Touch** and record words under each column.

See Hear Touch/Feel

Bowing sunflowers
Squabble and scratch
Rain shower

- 1. After reading, explore your yard and draw and label an Over/Under diagram of your backyard or garden to show us what is happening under the dirt and above the ground in your space. Challenge yourself to label your drawing using your senses to help us better imagine your drawing.
- 2. Choose an animal that visits your yard to learn more about. Examples might include: hummingbirds, bees, squirrels, butterflies, etc.
